

VILLAGE OF ALAMANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE DISPLAY OF STREET NUMBERS

WHEREAS, Fire and Public Safety Departments as well as other public agencies are required to respond to numerous situations and emergencies in the performance of their assigned duties; and

WHEREAS, a prompt response is facilitated by the ability to quickly identify the premises involved; and

WHEREAS, the display of assigned street numbers is one of the most important identifiers available;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF ALAMANCE, NORTH CAROLINA:

Section One. From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, all developed residential, commercial, institutional, office, and industrial premises within the Village of Alamance shall display the street number of said premises as hereinafter set forth.

Section Two. The street number assigned to the premises shall either be painted in black numerals at least six inches high on the curb in front of the improvements on said premises or may be posted in easily visible numbers either on the improvements or on a sign posted on the premises. Said identifying street numbers shall be of a size easily visible from the street right of way and in any event shall be at least two inches in height.

Section Three. Prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy or a Zoning Certificate for any premises, the Building Inspector shall require that said street numbers be posted as required by this Ordinance.

Section Four: This Ordinance shall take effect on the first of January, 2003.
